Dr. Edward B. Diethrich is board certified in general, thoracic and cardiovascular surgery. In Phoenix, Arizona, he is the Medical Director and Founder of the Arizona Heart Institute. Dr. Diethrich is also Medical Director and Chief of Cardiovascular Surgery at the Arizona Heart Hospital, where he performs state-of-the-art endovascular procedures using the latest devices, many of which he helped design and test in clinical trials.

A graduate of the Medical School at the University of Michigan, Dr. Diethrich completed his surgical residency training at St. Joseph's Mercy Hospital in Ann Arbor and Henry Ford Hospital in Detroit. After completing a two-year thoracic and cardiovascular surgery residency at the Baylor College of Medicine under the tutelage of famed heart surgeon, Dr. Michael E. DeBakey, he remained at Baylor as Assistant Professor in Surgery for six years.

Additionally, Dr. Diethrich is a voluntary adjunct professor in the Division of Clinical Education and a member of the clinical faculty at Arizona College of Osteopathic Medicine, Midwestern University, in Glendale, Arizona; a national advisory council member of the Cardiovascular Center at the University of Michigan Health System in Ann Arbor, Michigan; and a voluntary professor of surgery at the University of Kentucky Chandler Medical Center in Lexington, Kentucky.

Dr. Diethrich is an active member of more than 25 organizations, has received numerous awards and has authored several books and hundreds of scientific articles.
